

# **ASSEMBLY, OPERATION, PREVENTITIVE MAINTENANCE**

#### 1. FEATURES & MODELS

The **BORUM Industrial** Heavy Duty Auxiliary Stand is a reinforced pin style vehicle stand with a heavy duty design and support bracing system to sustain heavy vehicle loads up to 7,000kg. It's adjustable to match the job with a 1255mm minimum lift height and 1905mm maximum lift height. Featuring Heavy-Duty Industrial design, this tough stand is ideal for use under 2 post and 4 post vehicle lifts. With adjustable height increments, 3 choices of saddle attachments, and a stable tripod design, the feet (with base plates) securely hold this auxiliary stand in place when the spring loaded swivel castor wheels are under load. This heavy duty stand is mobile when needed and stable under load, so its a very handy peice of equipment when working under a vehicle lift. This tripod design ensures complete stability, even when your workshop floor is not perfectly flat. The Auxiliary Stand also has a spring loaded support beam.

#### 2. BEFORE USE

• Prior to each use conduct a visual inspection checking for abnormal conditions, such as cracked welds, metal fatigue, and damaged, loose, or missing parts.

#### 3. OPERATION

- 1. Do not exceed rated capacity. Overloading can cause damage to or failure of the stand. Use stands on hard level surface capable of sustaining the load.
- 2. Use only on a solid surface that will sustain the load eq. concrete.
- 3. Locate saddle at vehicle manufacturer designated support points. Always consult the vehicle lifting guide for the proper lifting points on any vehicle. These guides are available from the vehicle manufacturers.
- 4. Always place the load in the centre of the saddle only.
- 5. Always use a minimum of four stands to support and stabilize a vehicle, and a minimum of two additional stands for each additional axle assembly, before commencing repairs.
- 6. Do not apply horizontal forces or large torque loads to the vehicle whilst supported by Borum Auxiliary Support Stands.
- 7. Do not move or rock the vehicle whilst supported by Borum Auxiliary Support Stands.
- 8. Ensure that the support stands are stable and the vehicle is evenly supported before lowering onto the support stands.
- 9. Always carefully lower vehicle onto all support stands simultaneously.
- 10. Only use attachments, restraints or adaptors supplied by the manufacturer.
- 11. Always adjust height of support stand up to load with the extension tube all the way down first.

  Then raise the extension tube up to highest available pin setting.
- 12. Always ensure that locking pin is fully inserted into holes through entire base frame and that the hitch pin is securely retained on the other side.
- 13. The centre extension tube is spring loaded to assist in raising tube to desired height.
- 14. Use caution when pulling hitch pin. Built up spring force may raise centre tube suddenly.







#### Positioning Load

- 1. Locate vehicle manufacturer designated support points. Always consult the vehicle lifting guide for the proper lifting points on any vehicle.
- 2. Carefully select the appropriate saddle shape to best support vehicle load on designated support position.
- 3. Carefully position support stand, so that load is centered on the support stand saddle when load is lowered.
- 4. Adjust saddle height by removing the hitch pin and pulling out the locking pin, to allow the spring loaded centre extension tube to raise itself to the highest available position.
- 5. Ensure that the locking pin holes are aligned, then insert locking pin into the extension tube far enough to reinstall the hitch pin into the locking pin hole on the other side.
- 6. Ensure all support stands are adjusted to evenly support the vehicle and check that they have all pins securely locked in place.
- 7. Slowly lower the vehicle onto the support stands.
- 8. Check to ensure vehicle is secured before working on, around or under.
- 9. Always use wheel chocks on all un-lifted wheels in both directions to prevent inadvertent movement.

#### Removing and Lowering Load

- 1. **WARNING:** Clear all tools and personnel.
- 2. With a suitable lifting device, raise vehicle load clear of the support stands.
- 3. Carefully release the locking hitch pin and remove the locking pin. Use caution when pulling the locking pin as built up spring force may raise centre tube suddenly.
- 4. Push down on extension tube to slide it down to its lowest position.
- 5. Ensure that the locking pin holes are aligned, then insert locking pin into the extension tube far enough to reinstall the hitch pin into the locking pin hole on the other side.
- 6. Carefully remove the support stand, then carefully lower vehicle with the lifting device

#### 4. MAINTENANCE

This product shall be maintained in accordance with the following Maintenance instructions.

- 1. Visual inspection shall be made before each use of this unit by checking for abnormal conditions such as cracked welds, leaks, and damaged, loose, or missing parts.
- 2. Other inspections shall be made per operating instructions above.
- 3. Each unit shall be inspected immediately if the lift is believed to have been subjected to an abnormal load or shock. It is recommended that this inspection be made by a manufacturer's or supplier's authorised repair facility.
- 4. Owners and/or operators should be aware that repair of this equipment may require specialized knowledge and facilities. It is recommended that an annual inspection of this unit be made by a manufacturer's or supplier's authorized repair facility and that any defective parts, decals, or warning labels be replaced with manufacturers or supplier's specified parts. A list of Authorized repair facilities is available from the manufacturer or supplier.
- 5. Any unit that appears to be damaged in any way, is found to be worn, or operates abnormally shall be removed from service until repaired. It is recommended that necessary repairs be made by the manufacturers or supplier's authorised repair facility if repairs are permitted by the manufacturer or supplier.

• Prior to each use conduct a visual inspection checking for abnormal conditions, such as cracked welds, metal fatigue, and damaged, loose, or missing parts.

• Owners and /or operators should be aware that repair of this product may require specialised equipment and knowledge (refer to maintenance section).




This Borum Auxiliary Stand should always be stored in a dry location on a level surface.


#### 7. SERVICE & REPAIR

to extend the life of your TQB BRANDS Borum Heavy Industrial Vehicle Auxiliary Stand BAUXS7T

Regularly lubricate all springloaded castors and wheels for ease of movement.





5 Securing the vehicle.

A vehicle must have the park brake applied and the wheels chocked prior to raising to place a vehicle stand. Borum Pin Type Vehicle stands can only be used to support one end of a vehicle. The stability of a vehicle on stands is critical to the safety of personnel conducting repairs.

Regularly lubricate the Centre Column.

Lubrication of the centre column on your Borum BAUXS7T Auxiliary Stand allows for smooth height positioning. We recommend a light application of a general-purpose grease.







8 Borum BAUXS7T Auxiliary Stands come with a solid locking pin and safety latch attached to the body with a cable.

Once the correct height is reached, extend the spring-loaded centre column then insert the locking pin and safety latch prior to lowering a vehicle onto the stand or placing under a drivetrain or chassis part for support.



6 Correct Placement.

Borum BAUXS7T Auxiliary Stands come with a choice of three load adaptor heads that should always have the load cradle centrally positioned on the vehicle lift or drivetrain support points. Consult the vehicle manufacturer for lifting and vehicle stand loading points prior to elevating or supporting a vehicle or supporting suspended drivetrain parts.

 The V Head is best used to support Round Cross Beams and items such as Tail Shafts, Exhausts, Axies and provide support while other components are removed for repair.

 The Shallow sided U head is suitable for Gross Member support while removing Gearboxes and supporting Engines in situ during Drivetrain Repairs.

 The Beep sided U head is suitable for Chassis support allowing Suspension Repairs, Air Brake accessory and final lank removal



Borum BAUXS7T Auxiliary Stands must be used on a smooth horizontal surface.

Pin Type Vehicle Chassis Stands rely on a smooth flat horizontal surface to remain stable and minimise lateral forces. When raising a vehicle from an axle to place on stands the correct balanced lifting point must be used to prevent tipping or load collapse.

WHENNE: When used to support undirer stabilises a vehicle that is raised by a 2 a 4 post besit or in-the could lift, forum BABOSET i stands should always be used in pains. Aways use a minimum of four Stands to support and oltabilize a vehicle, and a minimum of low stands to support and oltabilize a vehicle, and a minimum of two additional stands for each additional stands around the vehicle manufacture of or fifting and vehicle stand leading points.



Hazards and Obstructions.

All wheeled TQB Brands equipment must be used on smooth surface free of cracks, crevices and tripping hazards that can foul the wheels during operation or relocation.

Personal Safety.

No persons should be in a vehicle that is supported by Vehicle Stands. Engine must be turned off. Testing of Drivetrain or running of Engines whilst a vehicle is on stands can create vibration and potential tipping of the vehicle.

Read the user Manual thoroughly and keep a copy easily accessible.
